Garret Keenan, Saint Rose (Jr., OF, Massapequa, N.Y.) - Batted .550 (11-for-20) with eight runs scored, six RBI, and four extra base hits. Hit for the cycle and went 5-for-6 with four runs scored and five RBI in Monday's non-conference win versus Saint Michael's. Hit safely in all five games last week and finished 3-for-5 with a run scored and a stolen base in the nightcap of Saturday's twin-bill at Bentley.

NORTHEAST-10 CO-PITCHERS OF THE WEEK



Ryan O'Rourke, Merrimack (Sr., SP, Worcester, Mass.) - In addition to a complete game shut-out win with 10 strikeouts against Pace on Saturday, O'Rourke picked up a save in the playoff berth-clinching 3-2 win over Southern New Hampshire by retiring the side in the ninth the following day. With 11 strikeouts on the week, he also drew within one of the program record for career strikeouts (183).



Chris Zbin, Southern Connecticut (So., SP, Colchester, Conn.) - Recorded the win in one appearance last week for the Owls. Struck out 13 batters in just six innings, allowed one run on two hits and walked only four batters against Felician.

Robert Kelly, Saint Anselm (Fr., 1B, Rancho Santa Margarita, Calif.) - Kelly batted .593 (16-27) with an .889 slugging percentage, hitting four doubles, two triples, three runs, and nine RBI in six games for the Hawks this week, getting three or more hits in four of those six games. He extended his current hitting streak to 13 consecutive games, and has had 31 hits in that span. Additionally, he pitched three solid innings on Thursday against Merrimack, allowing just one hit, a solo home run.

2010 NORTHEAST-10 BASEBALL WEEKLY INFORMATION



ADELPHI: The Panthers head into the Northeast-10 Conference Tournament as the fifth seed after finishing with a 29-17 overall record and a 15-11 mark in the league. The Panthers ended their season on a five-game losing streak, dropping a pair of conference games to Pace and Franklin Pierce. They also fell short against non-conference opponent Wilmington University, 7-5, on Thursday. AU will take on second-seeded Franklin Pierce (the host of the championships) on Thursday, May 6 in Game #2.



AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL: AIC went 1-3 last week to close out the 2010 season, splitting a home-and-home set with Saint Rose before getting swept in at doubleheader against UMass Lowell. Freshman starter Matt Lee allowed two runs on eight hits in seven and two-third innings pitched as AIC earned a 5-3 win at Saint Rose Wednesday. It was the first win of his collegiate career. Junior Dan Mooney batted .583 (7-12) for the week and was 4-for-4 with two RBIs and a run scored in the Yellow Jackets' win over the Golden Knights. Senior catcher Brenden Blaschke went 2-for-4 in the final game of his career, which ended with a ground-rule double in the bottom of the ninth in the second game against the River Hawks.



ASSUMPTION: Senior lefthander Michael Colebrook (Leicester, Mass.) pitched a five-hit shutout in his final game for the Greyhounds as Assumption College won the first game of a DH with Saint Anselm College (4-0). In the process, he tied the Greyhound career record for wins by a lefthander (19) with Hall of Famer Chris Eggert (1990-94). In the second game senior center-fielder Derek Migrants (Ayer, Mass.) became the career hit leader with 268, one more than Mike Baillargeon (2006-09). He also finished as the Hounds first triple crown winner (.425, 6 homers, 44 rbi) since Bill Bertrand in 2002.



BENTLEY: Denied in its bid to reach the Northeast-10 playoffs for the fourth consecutive year, Bentley will wrap up the season on Tuesday with a non-conference home game against Tufts University. Senior 2B Charlie Pagliarulo (Medford, Mass.), who has Bentley's highest scoring average since Roger Hill in 1998, has moved into third on the program's all-time hit list with 216. He's also number two in doubles, one shy of the school record of 55, and in triples, two short of the record of 13. Pagliarulo has also been hit by pitches 49 times in his career, 10 more than the previous school record. Junior RHP Rob Finneran (Garden City, N.Y.) has struck out 85 this season, exceeding the school record by 14.



FRANKLIN PIERCE: The Ravens closed out the regular season with a doubleheader sweep of Adelphi on Saturday afternoon, after losing to Massachusetts Lowell earlier in the week. In the first game of the doubleheader sweep, Jose Macias struck out 10 while allowing one run on three hits over seven innings. In the second game, Brian Maloney threw seven shutout innings, allowed three hits, did not issue a walk and struck out nine. Nick LaCroix hit .625 with one double and two home runs, walked four times, drove in four runs and scored six times on the week. Derek Ingui (.500), Mike Munoz (.500), Phil Hendricks (.385), Eric Pearson (.375) and Dan Kemp (.364) all hit over .300 on the week for the Ravens...Kemp hit a game-changing grand slam in the bottom of the fourth inning of Saturday's first game to turn a 3-1 lead into a 7-1 advantage. This week, Franklin Pierce is the second seed and will host the Northeast-10 Conference Baseball Championship Thursday through Sunday.



UMASS LOWELL: With their playoff hopes on the line last week, the River Hawks (27-19, 14-12 NE-10) did all they could with a perfect 3-0 record. Sophomore Cam Kneeland (Rowley, Mass.) made noise in the lineup, hitting three home runs and a triple while adding seven RBI. UMass Lowell got three stellar performances from its starting pitchers. Jack Leathersich (Beverly, Mass.) surrendered two earned runs while topping Franklin Pierce with 11 strikeouts through eight innings of the 5-3 victory. Dustin Ramey (Kingston, N.H.) allowed one run as he fanned five in seven innings of a 8-1 win against American International. Finally, Ted Haley (Cranston, R.I.) followed with nine strikeouts in seven shutout innings versus the Yellow Jackets in a 8-0 victory. Even though the River Hawks missed the Northeast-10 playoffs via a tie-breaker with Merrimack, UML still enjoyed its sixth straight season of 25 or more victories under head coach Ken Haring.



MERRIMACK: Needing to win the final three Conference games of the season, Merrimack swept Pace on the road and beat Southern New Hampshire at home to earn the first playoff berth in head coach Joe Sarno's seven years with the program. The Warriors were led during the week by stout pitching from senior lefties Ryan O'Rourke (Worcester, Mass.) and Dylan Ellis (Gloucester, Mass.) who each picked up a win against Pace on Saturday. O'Rourke also recorded a save in the playoff-clinching 3-2 win over Southern New Hampshire and in the process came within one strikeout of tying the program record for strikeouts in a season (183). Freshman Mike Laracy (Weymouth, Mass.) also showed poise on the mound, improving to 4-0 on the year with 7.1 innings against Southern New Hampshire.



NEW HAVEN: The Chargers went 2-2 last week with a pair of victories over Assumption and two losses at Stonehill. On Friday afternoon, fourth year head coach Raphael Cerrato won his 100th career game with a 5-4 win at Frank Vieira Field. Kyle Pettoruto hit a walkoff double in the bottom of the 10th inning. The offense was led by sophomore Jordan Kershaw who went 6-for-13 at the plate. Freshman Shane O'Connell led the team with four RBIs. This week the Chargers wrap up their regular season on Monday afternoon against Mercy College. UNH earned the third seed in the NE-10 Conference tournament and will travel to Rindge, N.H. for the opening round on Thursday to take on fourth seed Stonehill.

PACE: The Setters finished their season at 16-28 overall and 8-18 in conference play. Chris Spatkowski led Pace in a 3-3 week with a .565 batting average with four RBIs and two stolen bases. For the season, Spatkowski led Pace with 15 stolen bases, 45 hits, and 19 runs scored. Vinny Dammann led the Setters with four homeruns, 25 RBIs and 12 doubles on the season. Spatkowski finished sixth in the NE-10 in stolen bases, while Dammann was 11th in doubles and 12th in homeruns. Frank Luongo finished his Pace career second in school history with 13 saves and 17th in ERA with a 3.77.



SAINT ANSELM: The Hawks went 3-3 this week to close out the 2010 baseball season. They started the week with a 5-1 defeat over Merrimack, before falling 2-1 at Stonehill. They then split doubleheaders against Assumption on Saturday and Sunday, winning the first game 9-2 and the last game, 13-6, but dropping the middle two games 13-11 and 4-0. Robert Kelly hit .593 (16-27) with four doubles, two triples, three runs, nine RBI, and an .889 slugging percentage, extending his current hitting streak to 13 games. Matt Sucharewicz broke the Hawks' single-game home run record in game one of Saturday's doubleheader, hitting three home runs, and he then hit a fourth in game two.



SAINT ROSE: Junior left-hander David Batchelder gave up only three earned runs throughout his last six appearances that covered 45.2 innings of work. In the meantime, he lowered his ERA to a team-best 1.78. Junior right-hander Doug Dulin was effective as well down the stretch. Dulin gave up three earned runs and whiffed 21 throughout his last three starts, during which he tossed 20.2 innings. He finished the year 4-3 with a 2.01 ERA and a team-high 67 K's in 62.2 innings. Senior catcher Derek Marshall closed out his career tied with David Benyo ('01) as the school's all-time leader (NCAA era) with 43 career doubles.



SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT: The Owls went 3-0 in their last week of regular season play to finish with a 34-9-1 overall record and 21-5 conference mark, claiming the Northeast-10 regular season title for the second time in school history. The Owls concluded the week ranked No. 15 in the NCBWA Division II National Poll and No. 1 in the NCBWA East Region Poll, New England Poll and NCAA Regional Poll. They have won 10 of their last 11 games heading into this weekend's Northeast-10 championships. Freshman Michael Cleary continues to swing the bat well and is leading the team with a .331 batting average while riding a season-high eight game hitting streak. Ryan Geffert finishes the regular season ranked first in the conference in slugging percentage (.653), runs scored (50), RBI (54) and home runs (13). As of April 25, the Owls pitching rotation had the lowest ERA in Division II at 2.25. The Southern team that reached the 2005 World Series Championship also led the NCAA in lowest ERA for much of the season. The Owls claim the No. 1 seed heading into the NE-10 championships and will face the No. 6 seeded Merrimack Warriors on Thursday, May 6.



SOUTHERN NEW HAMPSHIRE: Sophomore Brad Monroe (Hampton Falls, N.H.) registered his 100th career strikeout Saturday against Southern Connecticut. With 113 career strikeouts, senior Steve Golbranson (Abington, Mass.) wrapped up his career ninth in career strikeouts with 113. Junior Tim Rines (Merrimack, N.H.) moved into SNHU's career top 10 for hits on Sunday and with 121 career hits, will enter his senior season ninth in program history in that category. The Penmen improved on their win total for the second straight year with 18 wins. It marks the program's most wins since 2006 and marks the fourth-highest win total for a single season.



STONEHILL: Stonehill has moved up to fourth in this week's NCBWA Division II East Regional poll. The Skyhawks were also ranked seventh in the most recent NCAA II East Regional rankings. Stonehill will be the fourth-seed in this weekend's NE-10 Championship, returning to the postseason for the first time since 2006. The Skyhawks ride into the postseason winners of seven-straight and ten of 12 after winning all three of their games last week.
