## Brian Beury ..... Head Coach - Men's Basketball



Brian Beury has steadfastly solidified himself as an outstanding basketball coach while developing a program that garners the utmost of respect from every corner, on every level of the collegiate game. Beury, who is in his 24<sup>th</sup> year at the helm of the Golden Knights, is again leaving an indelible impression upon a group of young men whose predecessors not only continually surpassed all expectations, but also provided The College of Saint Rose an avenue for

national recognition.

"We have been very fortunate to have had great coaches and great players throughout the years. We have found a formula that works for us at Saint Rose. One of our goals is to attract players who will fit in with the rest of the College's student body and who are poised to develop as students, people and as players. We want to develop a relationship where we'll be their coach for four years and their friends forever," says Beury.

Beury, who became just the 34<sup>th</sup> NCAA Division II head coach to reach the 500-win plateau last season, has an uncanny ability to instill his knowledge of the game into his student-athletes' performance. His teams have won an average of more than 24 games during the last 13 campaigns and have posted at least 20 wins on nine occasions throughout that span.

Saint Rose won five consecutive regular-season East Coast Conference (formerly the NYCAC) titles, prior to its entrance into the Northeast-10 Conference nine years ago, and has been awarded 11 NCAA Tournament bids in its 18 years competing exclusively at the NCAA Division II level. Saint Rose has compiled a 410-169 (.708) record during that time and has captured three NCAA Tournament Northeast Regional Championships on the way to three "Elite Eight" appearances and a trip to the "Final Four" in 1998. Furthermore, the Golden Knights advanced to the ECAC Championship Tournament in four of their non-NCAA Tournament years and came away with titles in both 1993 and 2001.

Beury has furthermore established the Golden Knights as a traditional power within the NE-10, which has sent five teams to the NCAA Tournament in four of the past five seasons. Saint Rose owns both the third best overall and conference winning percentages during its tenure, having won 63.2 percent of its games, including 62.6 of its league contests.

The 47-year-old mentor has compiled a 517-216 (.705) career record, has earned Coach of the Year plaudits on five separate occasions and was nominated for National Coach of the Year in 1989 when the program was still part of the NAIA. He stands ninth among the nation's most successful NCAA Division II

coaches in terms of victories. Additionally, his teams have qualified for postseason play in each of his 23 seasons and have won eight conference titles. Saint Rose has also played on national television, has had just one losing season under his tutelage and has won at least 19 games throughout 20 of his 23 years on the bench.

Impressive stuff indeed; but when you're intelligent, committed, and an outstanding recruiter in addition to being a student of the game; good things are bound to come your way.

Beury, who was Eastern Basketball's 1998 small college Coach of the Year, is in high demand on the lecture circuit. He has spoken at clinics throughout the world including the renowned Eastern Invitational and Five Star Basketball Camps.

Beury has also guided several college All-Star teams on summer tours throughout the world in recent years. He has coached college players on visits to Greece, Turkey, Spain, Cuba, Germany, Dominica, Montserrat, and Antigua to mention a few. He has also guided the Golden Knights on team trips to Spain, Italy, Cuba, Australia and Fiji.

A native of Queens and one of six children, Beury played high school basketball at St. Agnes before heading to Saint Rose where he was a four-year letterwinner. He was also the recipient of the College's 1996 Distinguished Alumni Award.

The three-time captain still ranks among the school's top-10 career leaders in both assists and steals. A two-time All-Conference selection who was the team's Most Valuable Player as a senior, Beury entered the collegiate coaching ranks at the tender age of 21 when he landed the assistant's position at the Junior College of Albany in 1982. Beury then returned to his alma mater in 1984 and two years later was named the College's second head coach. The rest you now know about.

Beury also directs his own successful youth basketball camp every summer at the College. He was the founder of the Saint Rose Summer Sports Academy and is also the founder of the New York State Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

Furthermore, Beury was actively involved with the development office as co-chair of the College's most recent capital campaign, *Advancing The Saint Rose Difference*. It marked the second time that Beury co-chaired a capital campaign at Saint Rose during his tenure.

Beury earned both his bachelor's degree in business administration and his master's in education from Saint Rose. He is taking a break from his M.B.A. studies at the College so he may spend more time with his family. He resides in Cohoes, NY with his wife, the former Mary Ann Grennon (Saint Rose '82), a member of the Saint Rose Athletics Hall of Fame, and their three children; Alexandra, Brian and Benjamin.

The Golden Knights have won at least 20 games in 11 of their 18 NCAA era seasons and have made 11 trips to the NCAA Tournament including three voyages to the "Elite Eight" and one trip to the "Final Four" throughout that time span.

**Last Meeting:** Saint Rose suffered a 75-70 setback to visiting Southern New Hampshire in the lone meeting between the two schools back on January 12. The Penmen outscored Saint Rose 48-22 in the paint and shot 57.1 percent (16-for-28) throughout the final 20 minutes.

The Golden Knights did not help their cause by coughing up the ball 20 times, which Southern New Hampshire turned into 20 points. The Penmen also generated 14 more shot attempts than Saint Rose thanks to a 14-7 margin on the offensive glass that helped produce a 15-8 advantage in second chance points.

Sophomore forward Brian Hanuschak and sophomore guard Shea Bromirski finished with 19 points apiece to lead Saint Rose. Hanuschak wound up with his fifth “double-double” of the year after hauling in 11 rebounds to go with a career-high five blocks. Freshman guard Andre Pope tossed in 16 points and handed out four assists in just 25 minutes of action.

Four players reached double-figures in scoring for the Penmen. Junior forward Tory Stapleton’s 20 point, 12 rebound effort marked his sixth “double-double” of the season. Senior guard Stephen Wood added 14 points, while sophomore guard Josh Morgan-Green and junior forward Cory Vejraska contributed 12 and 10 points.

**Last Time Out:** Saint Rose had its season-long six-game win streak come to a halt in an 87-83 loss at Le Moyne Wednesday night. The Golden Knights tied their season-high with 11, 3-pointers, but the Dolphins outscored Saint Rose 22-12 from the foul line.

With Le Moyne clinging to a 77-75 lead following a 3-pointer by Saint Rose senior guard Jermaine Clark with 2:22 remaining, senior guard Damani Corbin provided the final dagger for the Dolphins. Corbin converted a driving layup as he was fouled and then grabbed his own rebound off a missed foul shot that led to a pair of free throws by senior forward Laurence Ekperigin that put Le Moyne in front 81-75 with 47 seconds remaining.

Freshman guard Andre Pope went straight to the rim at the other end to cut the Golden Knights’ deficit to four, but the Dolphins drained 4-of-6 attempts from the charity stripe over the final 32 seconds and tacked on a bucket as time expired. Clark’s school record tying ninth trey cut the Golden Knights deficit to 85-83 with two seconds left, but senior forward Kevin Hassett broke free and dunked home the inbounds pass for the final margin.

Clark tied his career-high with 31 points after going 9-for-14 from the arc to again tie a single-game school record for 3-pointers. Pope finished with 11 points, eight assists and six rebounds, while senior forward Malcolm Williams added 11 points in 15 minutes of reserve action. Ekperigin and Corbin tossed in 23 points apiece to lead the scoring parade for Le Moyne.

**Series History:** The series stands tied 12-12 between two of the nation’s most venerable NCAA Division II institutions. Southern New Hampshire and Saint Rose owned the seventh and 11<sup>th</sup> highest respective D2 won-loss percentages entering this season. The Penmen have made 16 NCAA Tournament appearances, while the Golden Knights have made 11. The two clubs have met three times in the NCAA Tournament with the Penmen owning a 2-1 edge. Southern New Hampshire has also won all three NE-10 Tournament meetings between the two schools, each of which took place in Manchester. The Penmen handed the Golden Knights a 73-66 semifinal loss in 2003 and a 65-57 quarterfinal setback in 2004, along with last year’s 62-57 first round defeat. Thirteen of the 24 meetings between the two schools have been decided by five points or less, and three have gone to overtime.

**The Coaches:** Saint Rose head coach Brian Beaury is in his 24<sup>th</sup> year at the helm of the Golden Knights. He has compiled a 517-217 career record, has led Saint Rose to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances within the past 18 years, and entered the year ninth all-time in wins among active coaches at the D2 level. Stan Spirou is in his 24<sup>th</sup> season as head coach at Southern New Hampshire. The 1993, 1994, 1995 and 1999 New England Collegiate Conference Coach of the Year, Spirou has averaged an impressive 20.2 wins per-season and has led the program to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances, four NCAA Regional titles and six NECC Tournament championships. He owns a 498-248 career record.

**Scouting Saint Rose (16-11):** The Golden Knights wound up sixth in the NE-10, after being picked 11<sup>th</sup> in the preseason coaches’ poll. Saint Rose had its season long six-game win streak snapped with Wednesday’s 87-83 setback at Le Moyne. This month marked the first time in 12 years (1998-99) that the Golden Knights opened the month of February with a 6-0 record and only the second time (1996-97) they have done so during their NCAA era (1991-92). Finally, it represented their longest unbeaten stretch since 2007-08. Last year’s 62-57 first-round setback at Southern New Hampshire was the first time the Golden Knights failed to win their opening NE-10 Tournament game. Saint Rose has not trailed at the half throughout 15 of its 16 victories on the year. The exception was February 17 at New Haven (34-33). Saint Rose has also shot above 50.0 percent from the floor in eight of its last 11 games. Four players are averaging double-figures in scoring for the Golden Knights, all between 15.3 and 12.1 points per-outing. They have had five players in twin-figures scoring throughout two of their last four games, and seven times on the year. Not surprisingly, they are 6-1 in those encounters. Freshman guard Andre Pope has been in double-figures scoring in nine of the last 10 contests. Saint Rose is 11-3 at home; and 5-8 on the road thus far. Sophomore guard Shea Bromirski has been in double-figures scoring 39 times throughout 54 career games, including 15 of the last 17. The Golden Knights convert 42.8 (139-for-325) percent of their 3FG attempts, own a +5.4 rebounding margin, score 82.1 points and give up only 68.8 points throughout their 16 victories. Those numbers transform into 37.9 (78-for-206) percent, -4.5, 66.4 points and 78.7 points respectively during their 11 losses. Senior guard Jermaine Clark became only the 11<sup>th</sup> player in school annals to record 1,400 points (1,443) 10 days ago at New Haven. Bromirski (.454) and Pope (.428) are first and second in the NE-10 in 3FG% respectively. Sophomore forward Brian Hanuschak has recorded seven “double-doubles” on the year. Four players (Pope, Hanuschak, Clark, and Bromirski) continue to average more than 30 minutes of playing time. In fact, Clark is sixth in the league with 36.0 minutes per-outing.

That performance included an impressive 10-point win Saturday at Delta State that moved the Wonder Boys to 25-0 on the year. The 11th-ranked team this week is Florida Southern, with West Liberty, Rollins, Bentley and Fort Hays State coming in behind the Moccasins.
